Most of the Gospel readings during Ordinary Time this year are taken from the Gospel of St. Mark. Mark wrote his Gospel as a dramatic story with Jesus as the center. Jesus is always moving, inviting His disciples — and us — to follow. Mark wanted those who heard or read his Gospel to come to understand Jesus and recognize Him as the Son of God. As is typical, Jesus moves quickly through a growing crowd in next Sunday's Gospel, rebuking those who misunderstand His power, warning those who blaspheme against the Holy Spirit, and redefining their understanding of family.

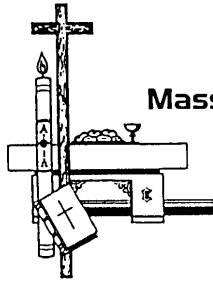
