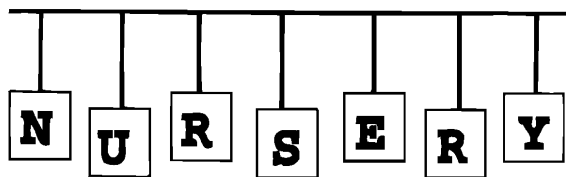

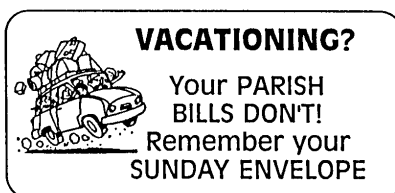

Knights of Columbus

Special Silver Rose Prayer Service-In 1960, to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe, a group of Knights of Columbus Squires in Monterrey, Mexico decided to run a rose from Monterrey to Tepeyac and place the rose at the feet of Our Lady on her feast day, December 12th. This practice grew to include Knights of Columbus from Canada and the US, as well as Mexico. The Bishop of London, Ontario Canada starts the "Run of the Rose" and the rose travels through Canada and the USA until it gets to the Mexican border in Texas and is handed over to the Mexican Knights of Columbus. Our local Knights of Columbus Council #6695 will receive one of three roses traveling to Texas for the December 12th feast day. On Sunday August 29th Deacon Juan Ibarra will lead us in a special prayer service here at St. Anne's at 6pm in the Chapel. A reception will follow in the commons. *All are invited to attend this celebration.*

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary....

Pope XII, after consultation with all the bishops of the Church, on November 1, 1950, proclaimed the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary a doctrine of the Faith. The dogma of the Assumption states that Mary was taken up body and soul into heaven, after the completion of her earthly life (in theological terminology, her dormition, or falling asleep in the Lord), since by reason of her Immaculate Conception she should not suffer the consequences of original sin. The Feast of the Assumption was celebrated by Christians as early as the seventh century. Today it is celebrated as a holy day of obligation in the United States on August 15.
