The year 2010 marks the 30th Anniversary of Abuse Alternatives, Inc.. This non-profit agency serves the cities of Bristol TN/VA, Washington Co. VA and Upper Sullivan County TN. They are the local domestic violence agency, providing services to families affected by domestic violence in their homes. Annually in emergency shelter, approx. 50 women and 50 children will be served. They will answer over 600 hotline calls and serve over 1200 victims through residential & supportive services.
