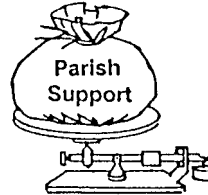

### WE Need Your HELP! Capital Improvements/Repairs

As Father Tim announced last weekend, our parish is looking at needing over \$100,000 for repairs for:

- The elevator (that serves the hallway outside the Great Room, the floor near the school office and the 3rd floor of the school) has had a catastrophic failure which needs replaced;
- We also need to replace the three\* air conditioning units located on the roof of the Great Room (which service the church, the Great Room, and the main hallway and bathrooms);  
\*(the cost for the crane is approx. \$8,000, replacing all three units this year is the most cost effective plan).
- The cemetery parking lot needs to be re-done to prevent damage to vehicles.

Beginning in July, the gray envelope in the envelope packet which says "Building Fund" will be used to help offset these needed capital improvement repairs. If you do not use envelopes, you can place donations in the collection on any weekend and on the memo line please note "Repairs". Thank you for your understanding, your cooperation and your generosity!
